Phylogenetic taxonomy places Aves in the dinosaur clade Theropoda.

The word is derived from the Latin root *alere*, meaning "to nurse, to rear, or to nourish" and indicates the need for young to be fed and taken care of for a long duration. effects of environmental chemicals have been published. Of special concern is the  
exposure of pregnant women and infants, as thyroid disruption of the developing organism  
may have deleterious effects on neurological outcome.

#### **Thyroid effects of endocrine disrupting chemicals**

ospreys was Organochlorine pesticides (ex. DDT), which were used to control insects.  
This chemical caused osprey's egg shells to soften and prevented the young from  
developing, which caused a huge decline in the population.
